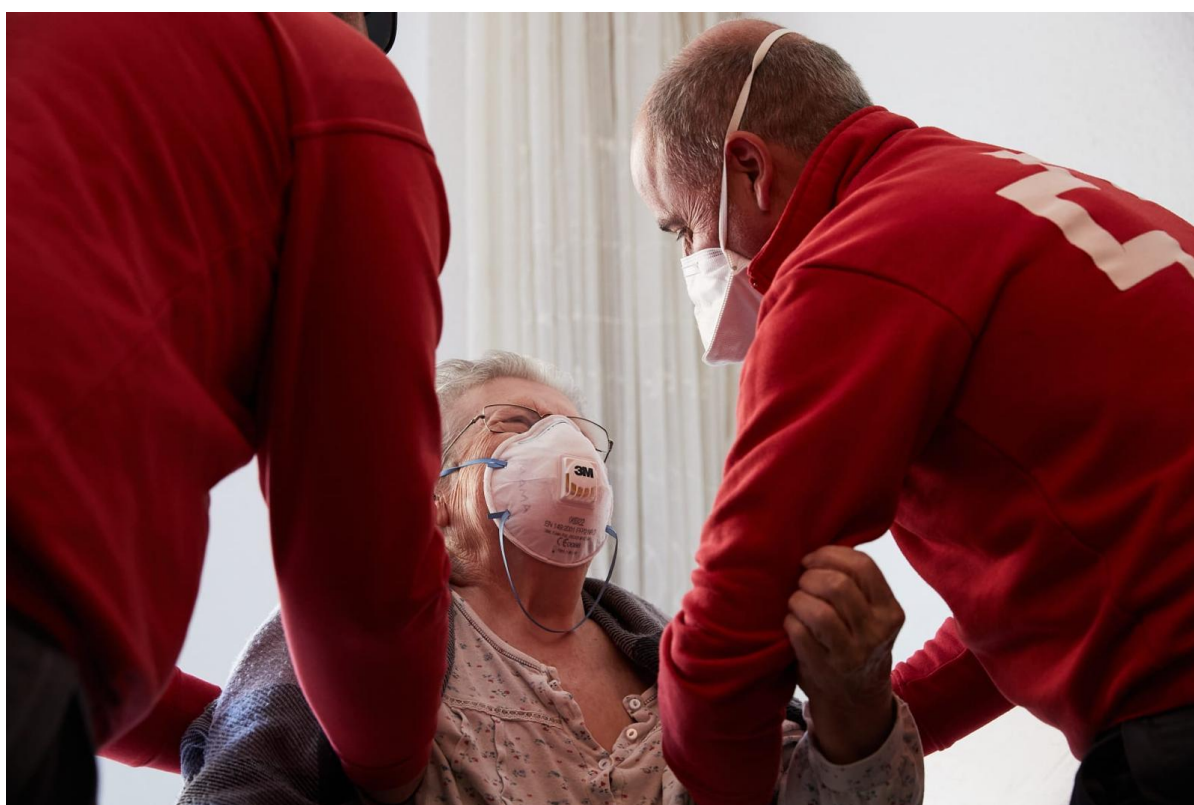

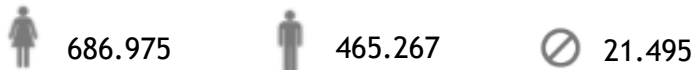

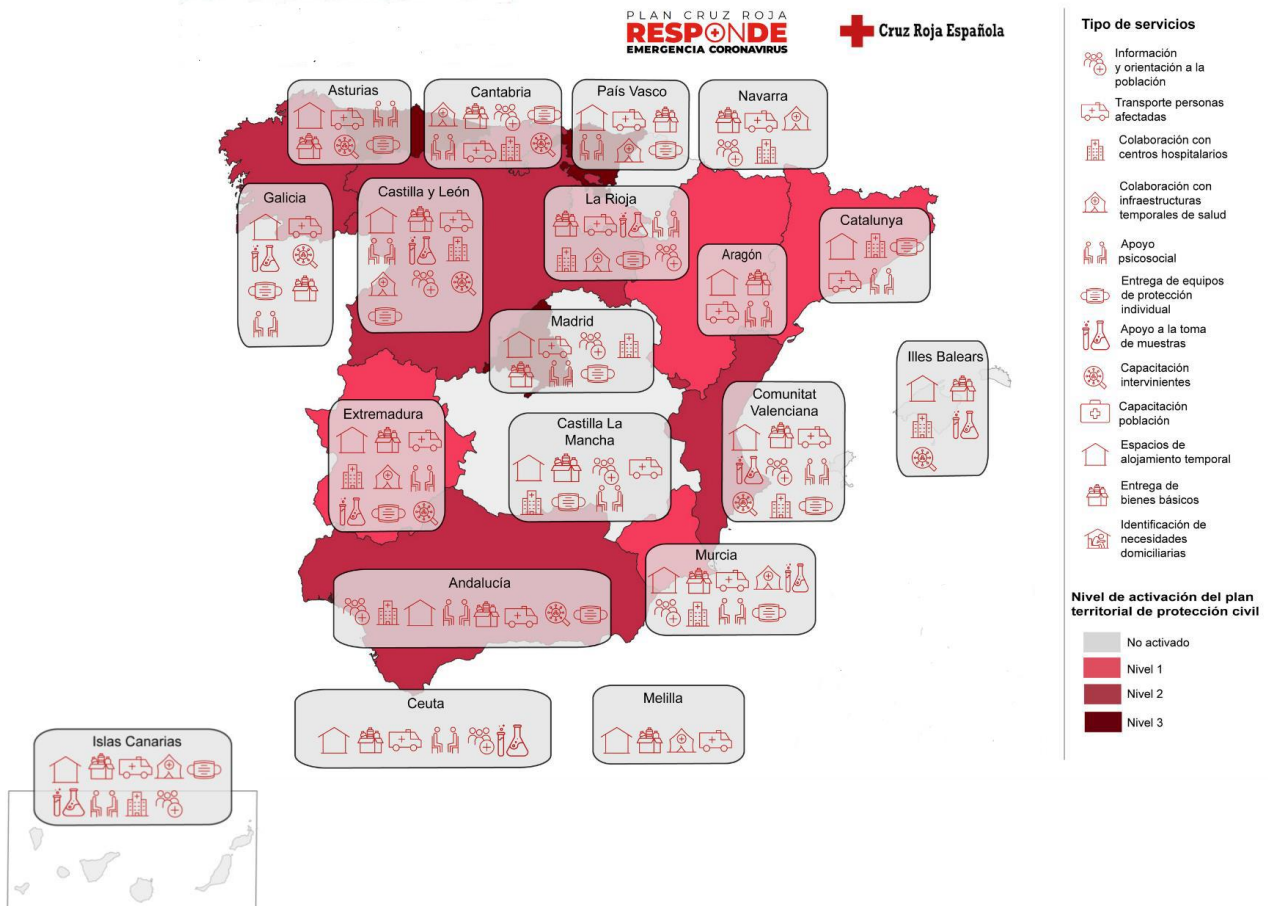

COORDINATION WITH PUBLIC AUTHORITIES

In our auxiliary role to public authorities and considering the decentralization of health, social and emergency services, Red Cross regional branches are being part of emergency coordination services in different levels. Progressively all branches have been incorporated and at the date of this report all have been integrated.

39 psychosocial emergency services.
3.855 interventions.



8.123 ambulance services.
593 ambulances available to support public health system.



Collaboration with **33 emergency coordination rooms and telephones.**



22 temporary additional health facilities established in collaboration with the health public system.



101 Shelters for confinement (some managed by Red Cross, some managed by other entities and where Red Cross provides logistics support).

4.467 places available.



8.905 kits (relief, hygiene, blankets...) distributed to vulnerable people in confinement or isolation in exceptional circumstances.



30 services of taking samples or bio measures
17.493 bio measures



1.304.905 articles of personal protective equipment distributed to general population.



HEALTH



620.228 people reached through contacts (agendas) to disseminate prevention and contention measures, adapting messages to specific vulnerable groups and identifying needs.



Bio-measures and symptoms monitoring: 15.401 people and 49.305 follow-ups.



Accompaniment to health facilities: 468 people and 905 accompaniments.
5 hospitals and 1 health-social centre, 474 beds available to health system.



Psychosocial assistance: 2.854 people and 5.584 follow-ups.



Pharmacological assistance: 9.739 people and 12.151 deliveries.

Food and essential non-food items: 276.638 people and 451.934 deliveries.



Cash assistance: 28.431 people and 35.341 deliveries.



Accompaniment for essential procedures (shopping, bank...): 32.988 people and 43.490 mobilizations.



Social information (to elderly people, women affected by gender-based violence and other vulnerable groups): 171.521 people and 218.635 contacts for information.



Social accompaniment by phone to people in situation of loneliness: 18.394 people and 39.526 agendas.



Social Emergency Units: 1.330 vehicles.



Support for shelter: 3.662 people

Information about employment: 9.244 people and 12.179 activities.



Labour orientation: 15.783 people and 17.422 activities.

COVID-19 course for responders (including personal protection equipment procedures and other safety measures) and **psychosocial support courses:** **20.363 volunteers and staff and 55.850 registrations**



291.502 people have taken the Red Cross COVID-19 online course.



63.595 people have taken the Red Cross first aid, emotional wellbeing... online course.



School support: 8.748 kids and 33.707 activities.



Online training for employment: 300 people and 405 workshops.
